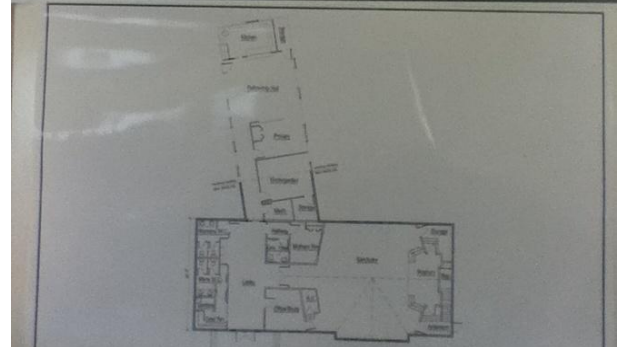
Wind Chimes can be very pretty, but can also disturb the sleep of those nearby. Please wait until you are home to enjoy them. Thank you.
