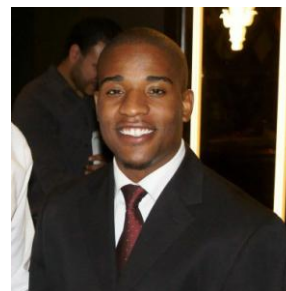


Please Also Welcome

He will be the speaker at the 7:15 p.m. evening meetings from Sunday to Saturday inclusive.

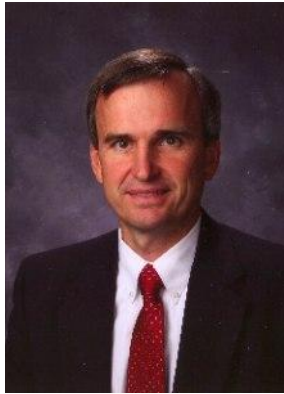
