**Dr. Mark Havnal** is 24<sup>th</sup> president of Canadian University College. He has led the university since July 2010. A career educator, Haynal began in 1981 as Principal of the Anderson Seventh-day Adventist School Indiana. After serving as Boys Dean and Choir Director Indiana at

Academy for four years, he returned to administration serving as principal and teacher at the Milwaukee Junior Academy from 1985-1988. Beginning in 1988 Haynal served as principal and teacher at the Midland Adventist School until he moved into the principal's position at Rogers Elementary School in 1992 until 2000.

Dr. Haynal made the move to higher education in 2000 taking a position as an Associate Professor at Walla Walla University, in Walla Walla, Washington. In 2002, he assumed the role of Dean of the School of Education and Psychology for the same institution. Since 2006, Haynal has been the Superintendant of Schools for the Seventh-day Adventist Church in Indiana, USA.

Dr. Haynal holds a BA in Elementary Education and a BS in Journalism from Andrews University, an MA in Education Administration from the same university, and an Ed.S and Ed.D from La Sierra University. He and his wife, Kris, have two adult daughters and one grandchild.
