

Everybody Please Welcome Peter Kulakov

Peter Mikhailovich Kulakov is a television evangelist, founding director of the first Christian Media Center in the former Soviet Union, pastor, and overseas missionary. He was the first Christian to appear live regularly on two national communist radio networks, blanketing 11 time zones with 900 FM stations. In 2005 he started a weekly Light of Hope television program in two languages, Russian and English. Kulakov presents regular major satellite evangelistic series of meetings live from, Moscow, Kiev, London, Darmstadt and many other cities of Europe and Asia. Thousands of people accepted Jesus as Savior and joined the church as the result of these meetings. He will be the Speaker at the 9:00 a.m. meetings from Sunday to Friday inclusive, as well as the Youth Speaker at the Monday morning meeting in the Youth Tent.

Truro Church Building Project

The Adventist Congregation of Truro is pleased to
announce the renovation/expansion of its church
building, beginning this summer.

Besides altering the outside appearance of the
building to make it recognizable as a place of
worship, plans include upgrading the electrical
and heating systems; replacing the old sagging
entryway; adding a mothers' room, a
handicapped-accessible washroom, and two
classrooms for children's divisions; thus creating a
truly family-friendly facility.

Construction will begin in earnest the Monday
following Camp Meeting, with the removal of the
old entryway; and foundation work will
commence the following week. A team from
MARANATHA Volunteers International will
arrive on September 11, planning to complete the
framing and exterior finish in just two weeks!

Fund raising has been on-going, but we are still
more than \$40,000 short of our goal — and the
congregation has committed to avoid debt by
proceeding no farther than funds on hand will
permit. Recently, a matching fund has been
pledged; to match all donations up to \$10,000
received between Camp Meeting and December
31 of this year.
