SAVE OUR HORSE PROGRAM



As you may know, **the horsemanship program** at camp operates only from fees received from horse camps and donations.

During the summer, we offer the program *Horses Highlighting His Word*, which parallels our relationship with God as our "Master" and a horse's relationship with its master.
